On 5 October 2012 the following textbooks were received at the Central Warehouse in Polokwane.

- 5.1 4,320 Mathematical Literacy textbooks;
- 5.2 1,534 Geography textbooks; and
- 5.3 the remaining 14,314 Life Sciences textbooks.

Although not stated in Mr Subban's supplementary affidavit, but as was conveyed by counsel representing the Respondents on 2 October 2012, 55,000 Life Orientation textbooks were delivered to the Central Warehouse in Polokwane on 28 September 2012.

The textbooks were sorted and packed over the weekend of 5 - 7 October 2012.

All outstanding textbooks were thereafter delivered to all the schools that had reported the shortages, which delivery took place on 8 and 9 October 2012.

In respect of the subjects referred to hereinbefore the delivery of all outstanding textbooks were made to the schools. The delivery of all outstanding textbooks was therefore completed by 12 October 2012. The Department is in possession of the proof of delivery documents which are not annexed hereto because of the voluminous nature thereof.



10.1 Life Orientation - 370 schools;


10.2 Life Sciences - 354 schools;
